Marketing

- Develop target list of media outlets that would be interested in covering LYCA's work in the community or featuring our Founder, Celines Toribio
- Actively pitch and call media for interview and coverage opportunities
- Research and reach out to key events where LYCA should be present, i.e. educator events, Principal meetings, etc.
- Manage School Outreach database and update with school contact and principal information
- Assist with editing assignments, i.e. website content, press releases, etc.

Fundraising Projects

- Research city, state, and federal grants that may apply to LYCA's work with young girls
- Manage Fundraising database with all respective deadlines and submission requirements
- Draft grant applications, and collect any necessary documents for final submission
- Outreach to corporate entities that provide funding for youth programs

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School students and College-enrolled students are eligible to apply
- Fully bilingual in English and Spanish
- Dynamic, self-motivated, outgoing, and highly organized individual
